

# Wildfires types

From the underground → up high to the canopies

### **GROUND FIRES**

Slow
Difficult to contain and suppress
Heavy damage to roots



### **SURFACE FIRES**

Can become ground fires



### **CROWN FIRES**

Fast spreading









# Wildfires types

Wildfires include the **WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE** 

#### **SPOTTING FIRES**

Can travel a long distance



### WILDLAND URBAN **INTERFACE FIRES**

High risk for human settlement Need specific managment procedures



#### **RURAL FIRES**

Limited risk and large geographic area

#### WILDFIRES INCREASE GLOBAL WARMING

#### **GLOBAL WARMING INCREASES WILDFIRES**

Altered Carbon balance
Reduced reflectivity of glaciers

Impacts of wildfires key drivers

Intensifies fire behavior

Dries vegetation

Alters fire regimes

Increases lightening activity

Threats forest regeneration

Increases length fire seasons
